- RSV activity significantly increased from 11 to 41 positive tests from Week 3 to Week 4.
- Influenza-like illness is increasing in Los Angeles County.
- While influenza activity remains low in Los Angeles County, it is increasing in California.

Influenza Activity: CA & USA

From 1/14/07-1/20/07 (week 3), influenza activity in the United States remained at approximately the same level as week 2 and influenza-like illness (ILI) was above baseline level.

Influenza activity in California was upgraded to **regional** (outbreaks of influenza or increases in ILI and recent laboratory confirmed influenza in at least 2 but less than half the regions of the state), primarily due to activity in Northern California.
