## PREPARING FOR YOUR VISIT

These tips will help you get ready for your visit:

- Bring a book, crossword puzzle, or other activities to keep you busy during your wait.
- Eat before arrival. Eating and drinking is not allowed inside the clinic.
- If arriving with a guardian, an authorization letter from the parent must be provided during registration.
- If your child is getting an immunization, bring his or her yellow Immunization Card so it can be updated.
- Be on time if you have a follow-up appointment or it may be rescheduled; if you need to cancel an appointment, please do so at least 24 hours in advance.

## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING

**The Dial-A-Ride Program** is also available for clients that live in the rural zones. Phone (661) 945-9445 ext. 1 or (855) 833-8541 between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Reservations may be made up to two days in advance and on the same day. Reservations are made on a first-come, first-served basis. To better serve the community, passengers are limited to three (3) rides per day.
