PrEP naive clients who initiated PrEP between September 29, 2016-September 28, 2018















PEP Client Demographics



Repeat PEP and PEP to PrEP

16% of clients transitioned to PrEP after PEP and 10% of clients initiated PEP at least twice



Predictors of Repeat PEP Use

- Clients that reported previous PEP use at COE intake*
- •TGP more likely than MSM or HET*

Predictors of Prep After Pep

- ◆TGP more likely than MSM or HET*
- MSM more likely than HET*
- Latino MSM more likely than white MSM*







Risk indicators for Latino MSM retained > 3 months (n=716)









Black MSM retained on PrEP reported a decrease in the number of partners from intake to follow up (n=132)









TGP retained in PrEP at least 3-months reported a decrease in HIV risk factors from intake to follow-up (n=94)













Women retained in PrEP at least 3-months reported a decrease in HIV risk factors from intake to follow-up (n=27)














Number of Clients Enrolled in DHSP Contracted Services




Proportion of Contract Enrollment Goal Achieved
