Shopping Cart Guidelines

Clean shopping carts play an important role in keeping foods free of contamination and providing customers with an enjoyable shopping experience. As a food facility operator, you are responsible for proper shopping cart maintenance. The information below will help you understand what you are responsible for and how you can meet those responsibilities.

Responsibilities of food facility operators

- Only use shopping carts for their intended purpose. Do not use carts to collect or transport trash or recyclable materials.
- Monitor shopping carts for cleanliness and functionality. Clean dirty carts and repair or replace broken carts.
- Evaluate retrieved shopping carts. Ensure they are clean and in proper working condition before making them available for customers to use.



Getting the job done

Making sure the responsibilities above are met takes coordination and planning. The following guidelines will help you get the job done:

- Train all employees to ensure that they do not use shopping carts to collect or transport trash or recyclable materials.
- Establish a cleaning schedule to routinely clean dirty shopping carts.
- Take immediate corrective action to repair or replace broken shopping carts.
- When abandoned shopping carts are returned to the store, clean them before making them available for customers to use.
