
#### Percent of Total Live Births by Source of Payment for Prenatal Care (PNC) Los Angeles County, 2015



# Percent of Total Live Births by Birth Weight and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2015



#### Percent of Total Live Births by Parity and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2015







### Percent of Total Live Births by Birth Weight and by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2015





#### Percent of Total Live Births by Gestational Age and by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2015










