

Distribution of Live Births by Birth Weight and by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2016





Distribution of Live Births by Mother's Trimester Prenatal Care (PNC) Began and by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2016








