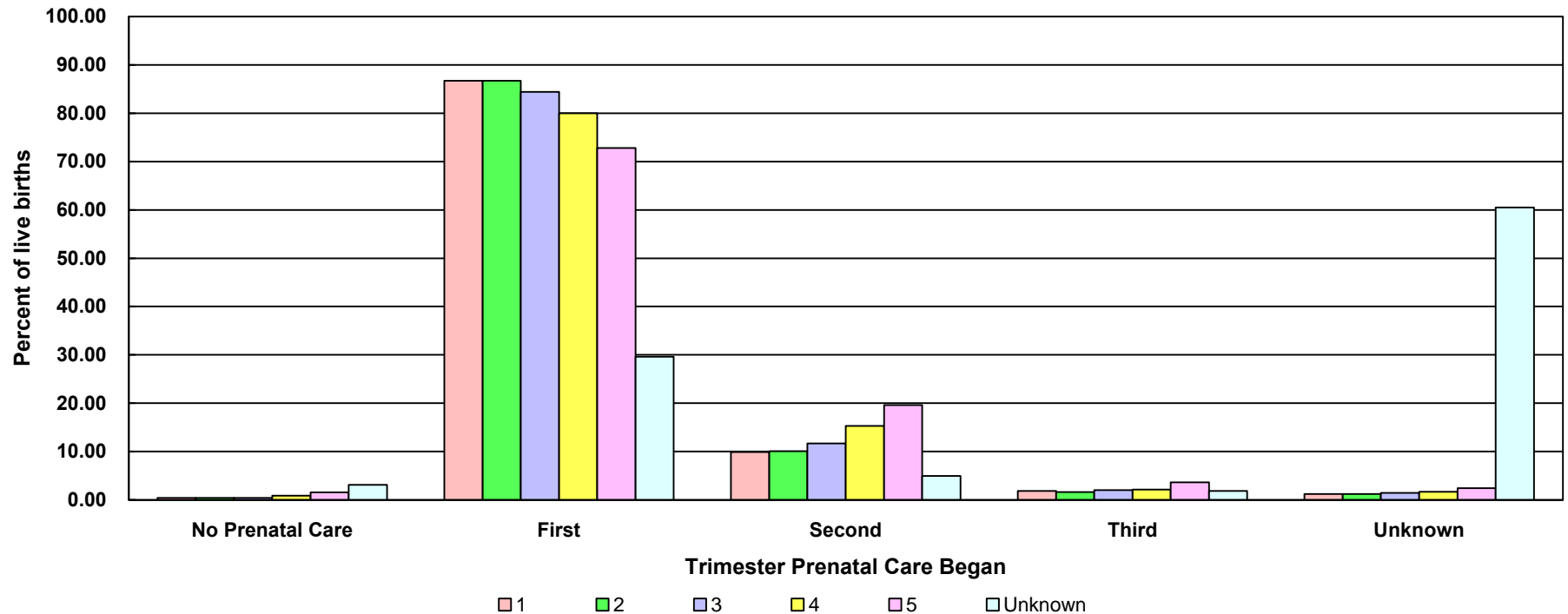


**Percent of Live Births for Mother's Trimester Prenatal Care Began by Parity**
