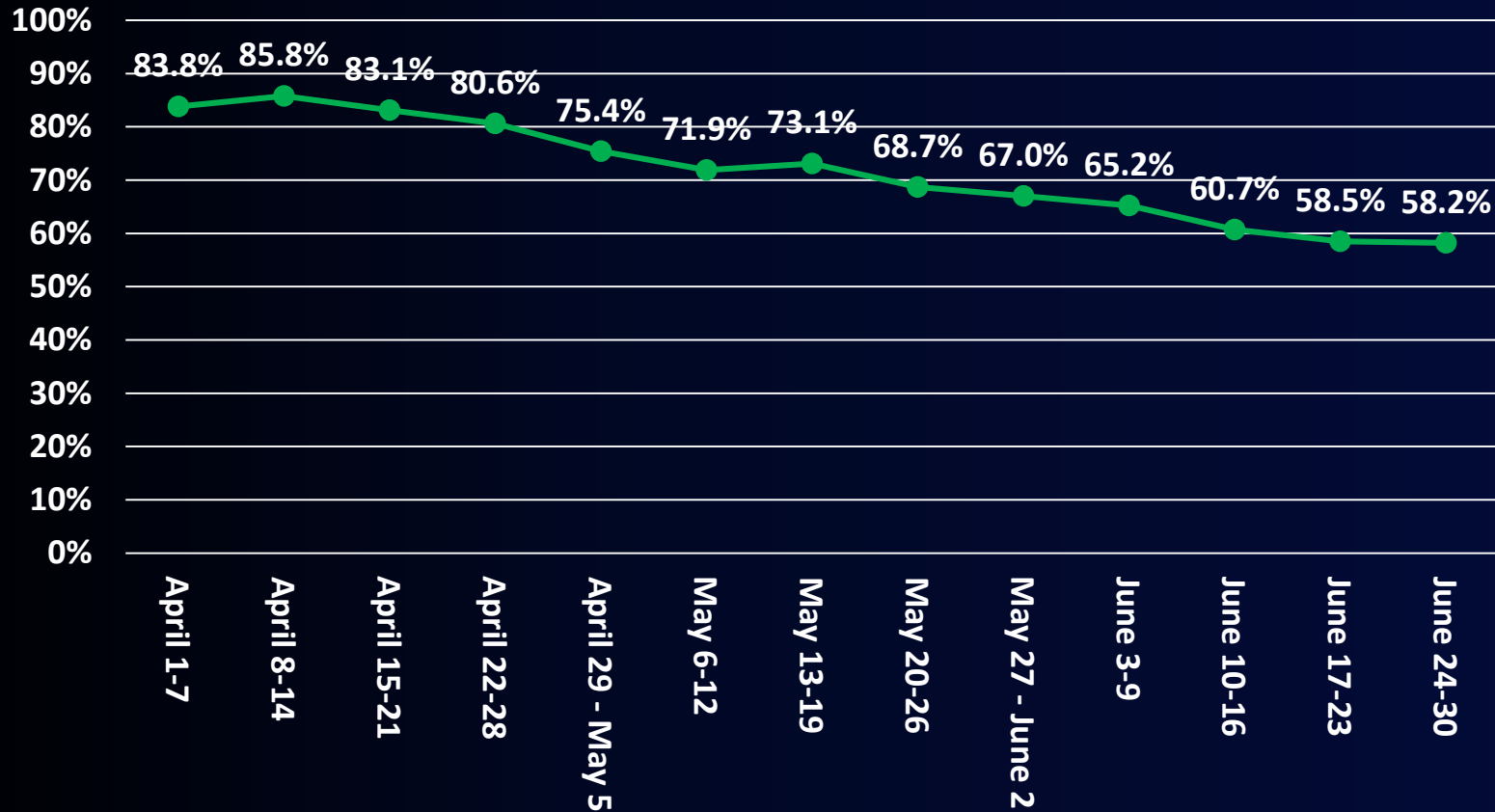
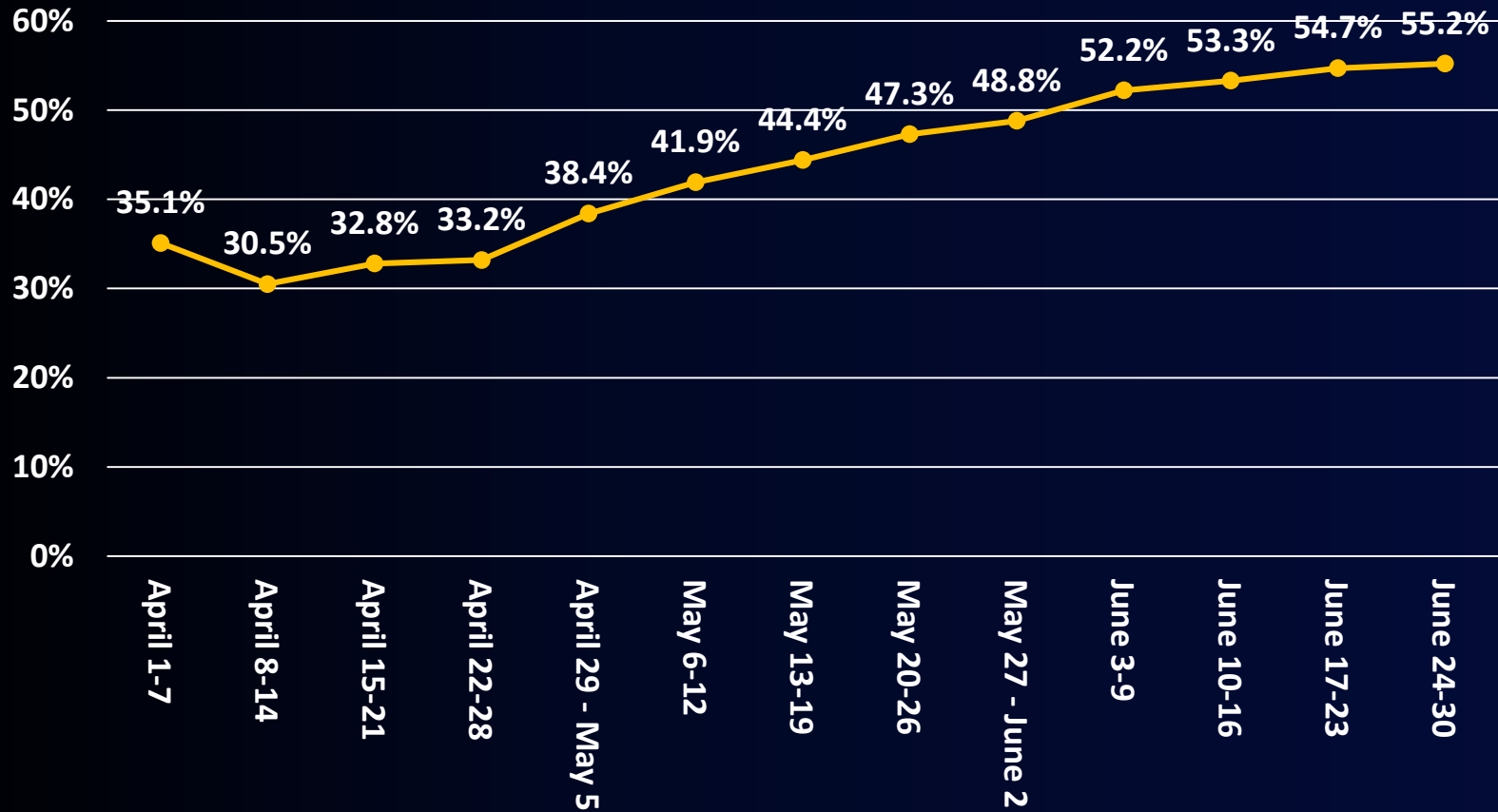


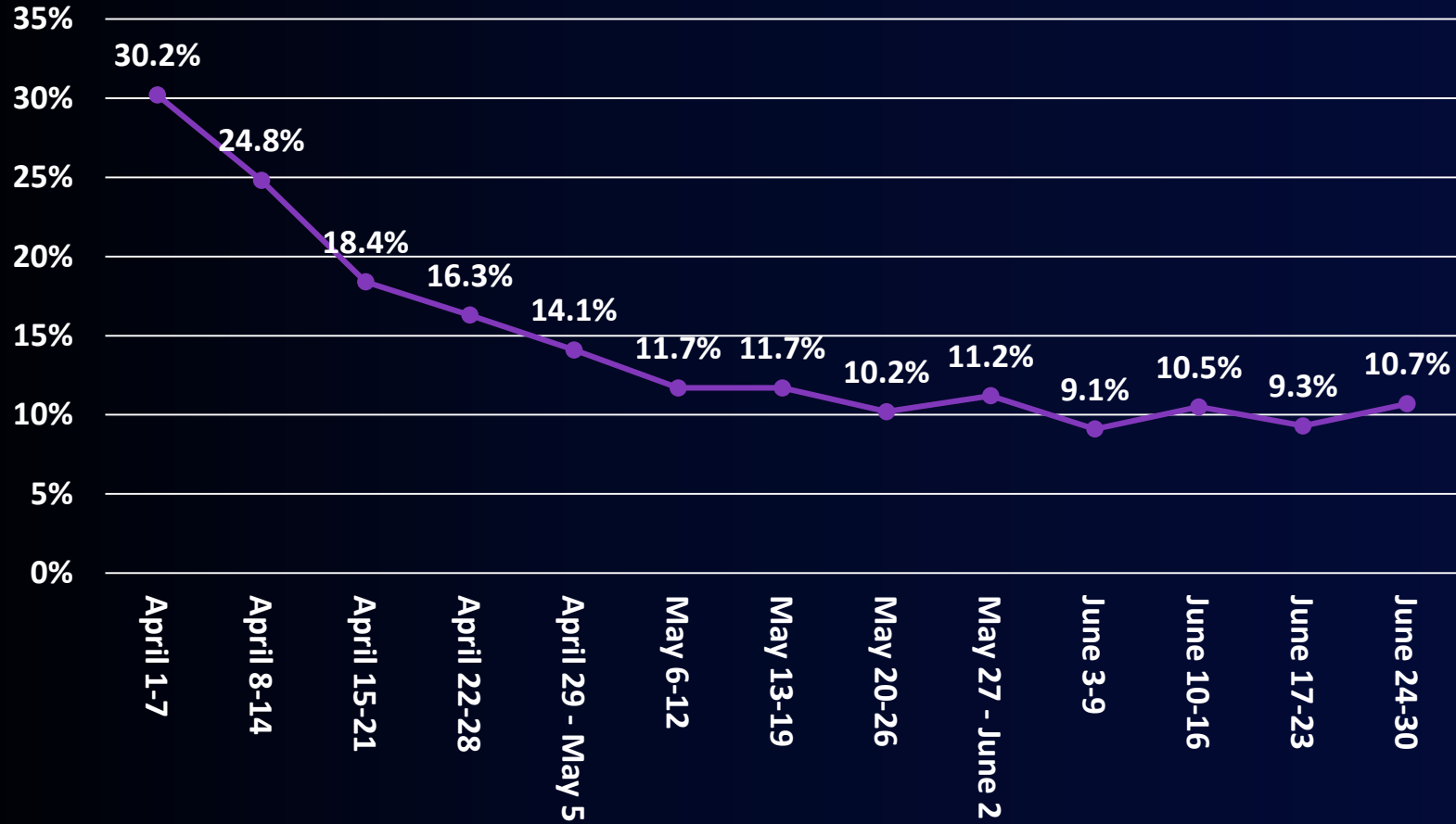
Percent of LA County residents who have remained in their residence at all time (except for essential activities or exercise) in the last 7 days



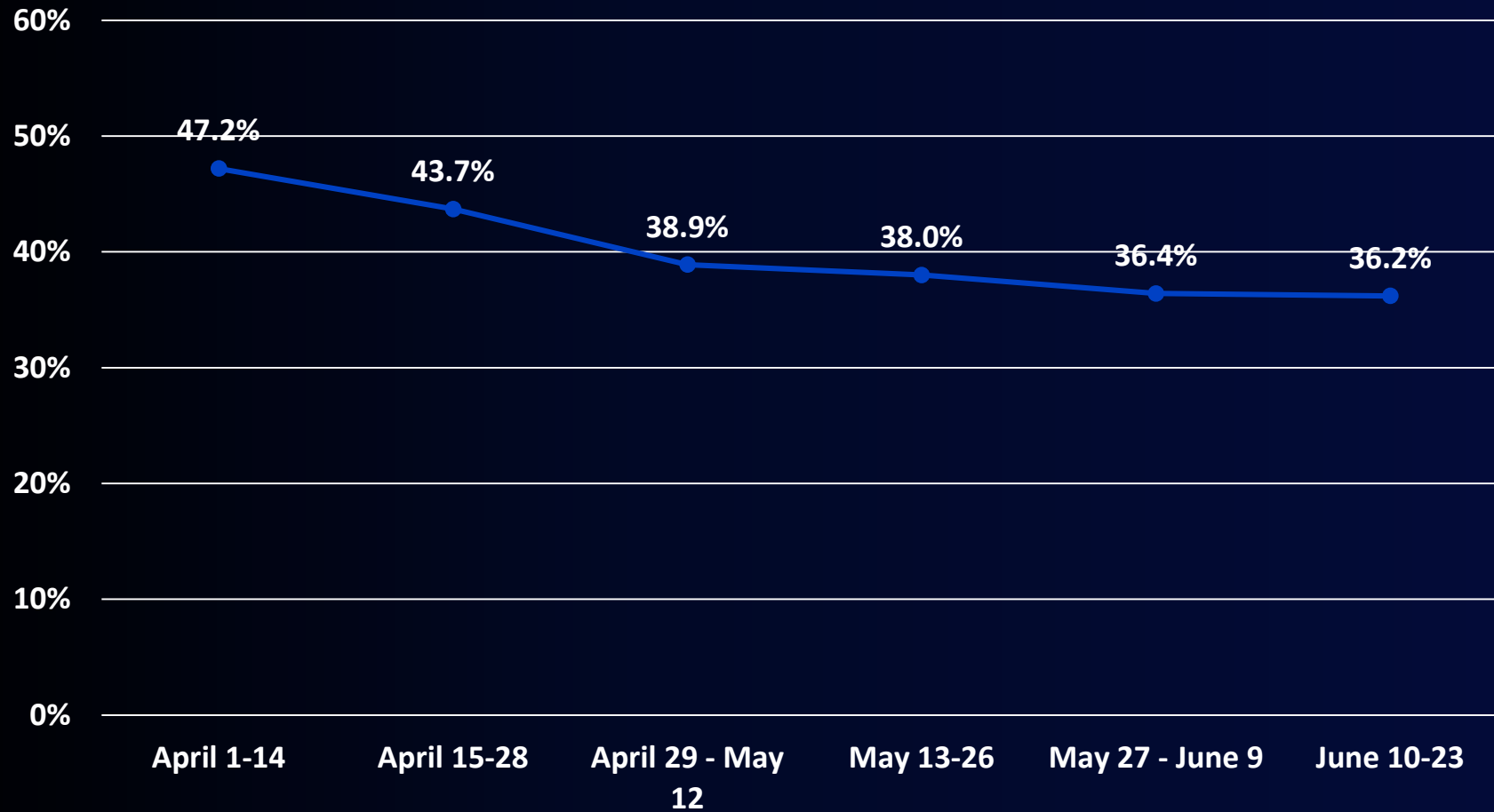
Percent of LA County residents who had close contact (within 6 feet) with people who do not live with them in the last 7 days



Percent of LA County residents who were worried about running out of food because of a lack of money or other resources in the past 7 days



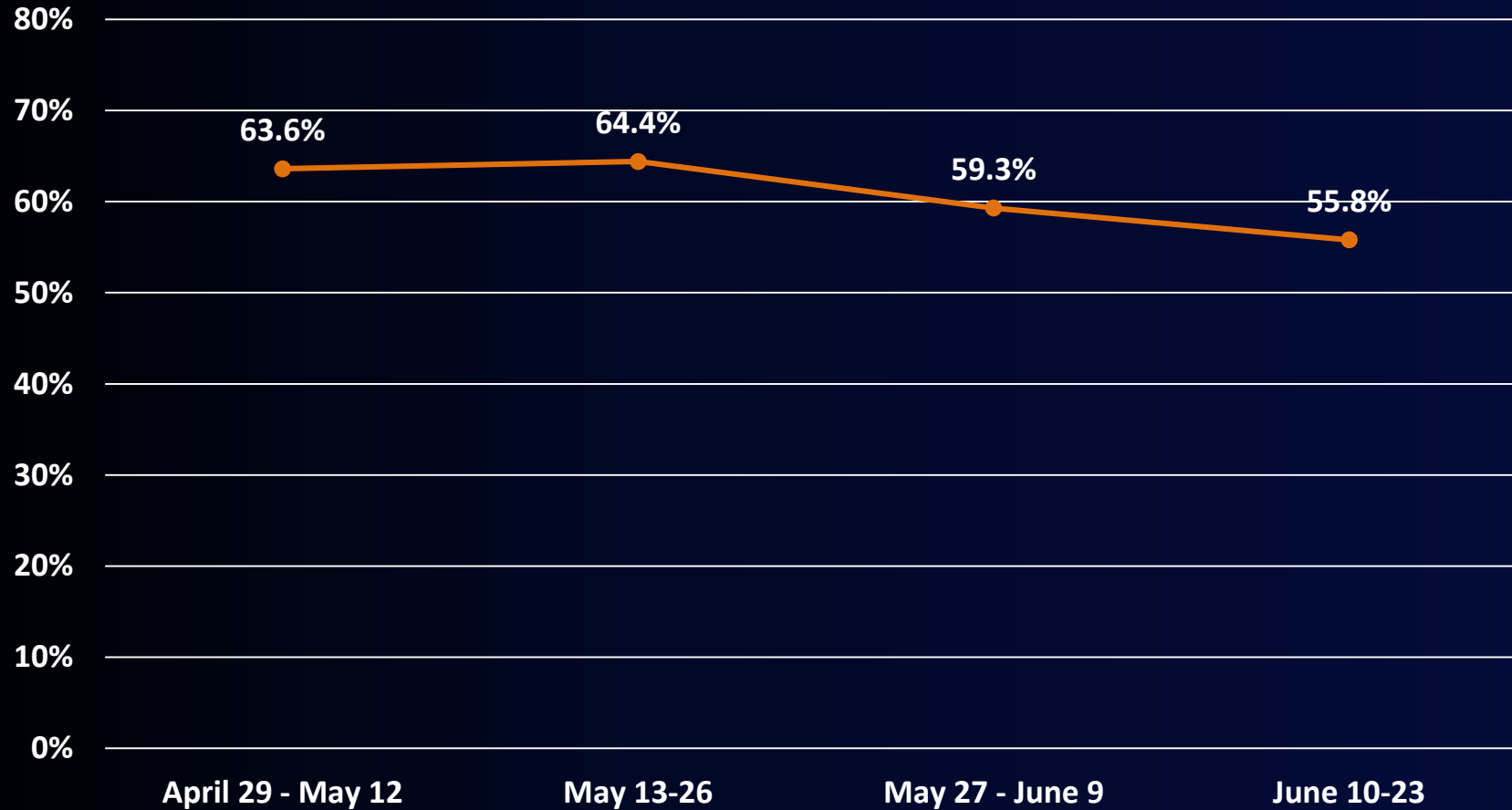
Percent of LA County residents with mild, moderate, or severe symptoms of psychological distress (PHQ4)

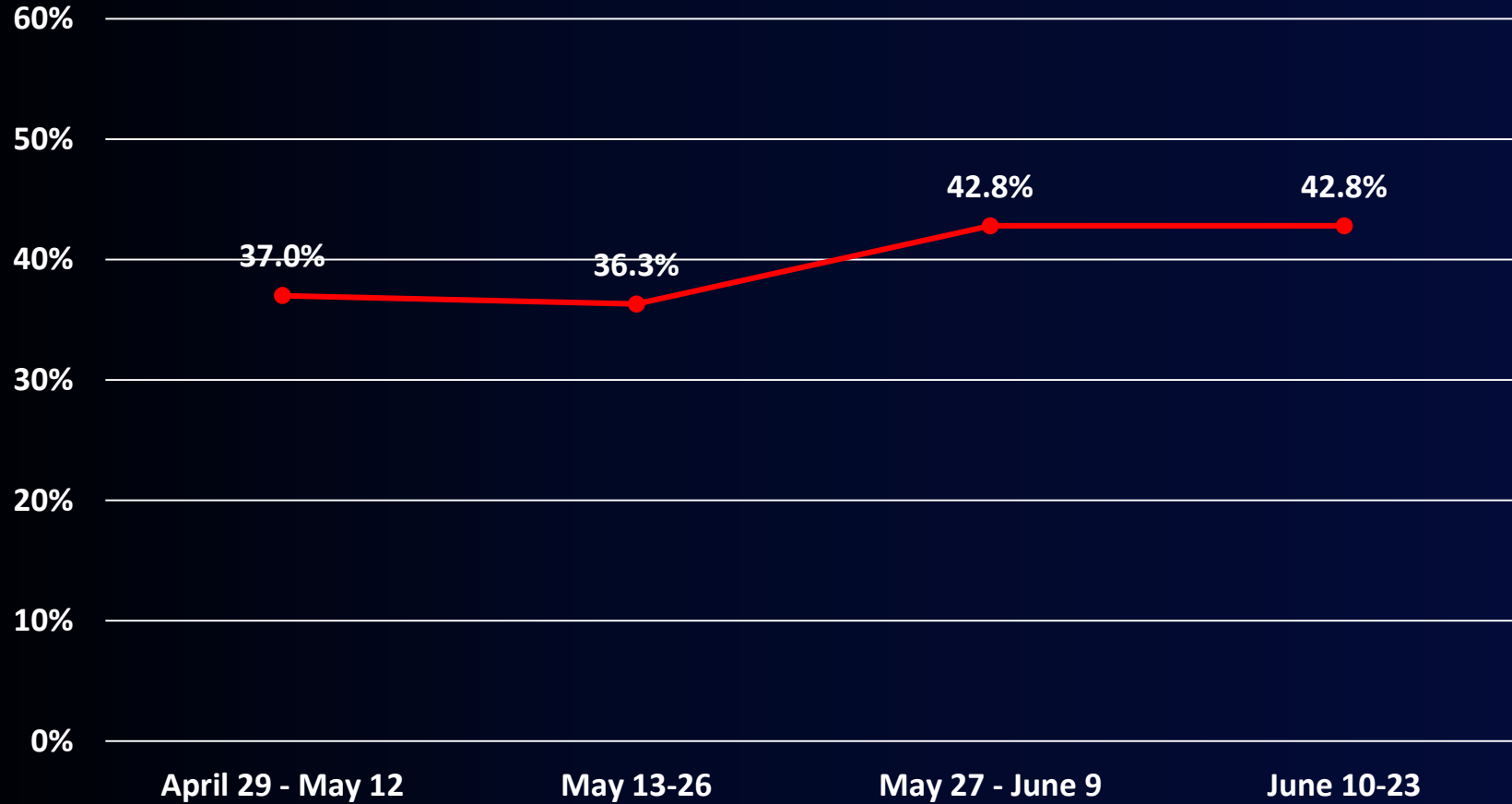
Percent of LA County residents who reported the coronavirus outbreak poses a moderate or substantial threat to their household's finances
