

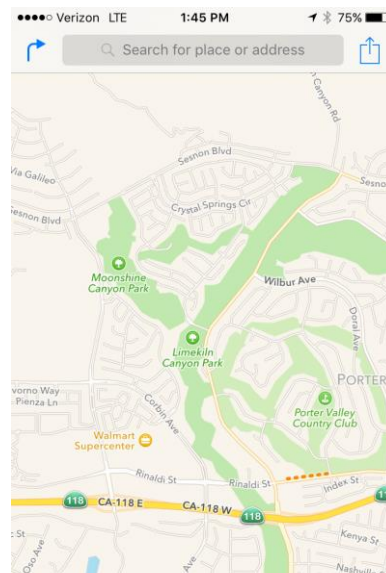
**DIRECTIONS FOR SMART PHONE USERS**

When you are walking around in your neighborhood and observe odors, send us a message about where you are when you smell an odor using your phone's map application to tell us precise location information.

1. Click on your phone's Map Application

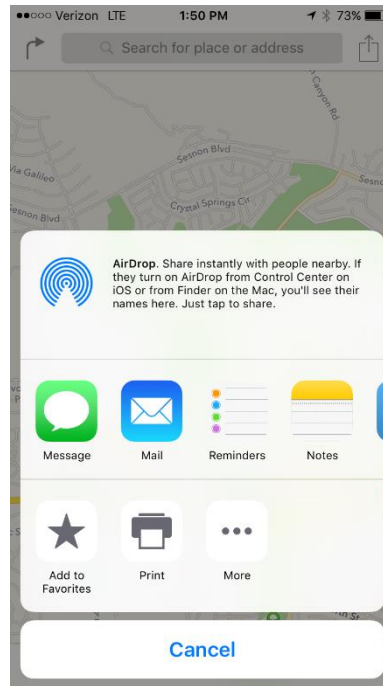


2. Click on the symbol to send your location

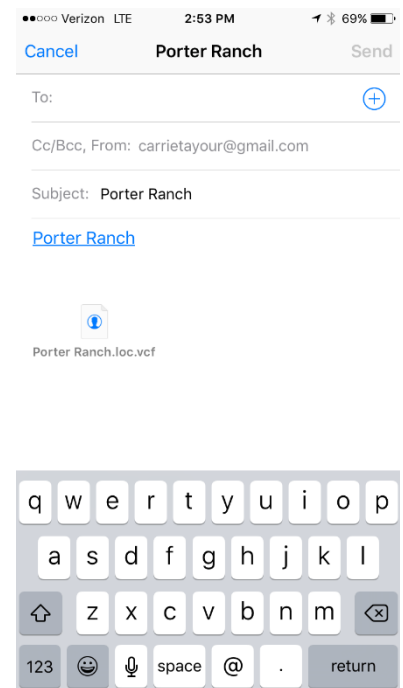
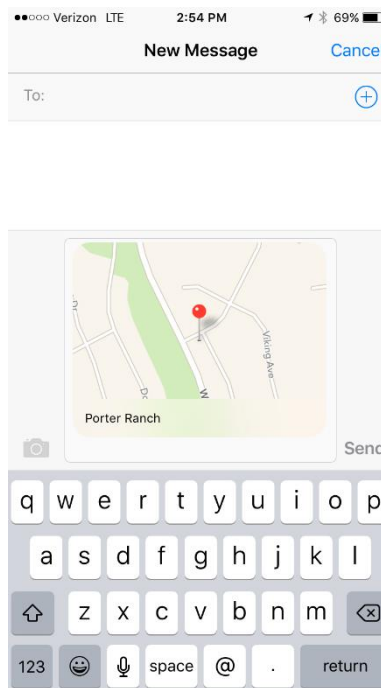

4. Type in the phone number **(213) 282-6980** or email address **odor@ph.lacounty.gov**



5. Include in your text message or email:

- Description of what it smells like
- Tell how long the odor lasted (was it fleeting (one time), intermittent (on and off), or constant over a certain time)
- Intensity rating between 0 (no odor) and 5 (the worst odor that you have smelled since the leak began)
