Nail Salon Workers and Owners

- □ 60-80% areVietnamese in CA
- 95% are women of child-bearing age
- Most are recent immigrants with limited English
- Lack access to health care and legal services
- □ Most earn less than \$18,200 per year

Chemical	Possible Health Effects
	(cancer & reproductive)
Dibutyl phthalate	Animal studies have suggested low birth weight, cleft palate, asthma. Also found in Glue.
Formaldehyde	Increased risk for cancers of nose and throat. Burning, watering eyes. Skin rashes. Also found in Cigarette smoke
Toluene	High levels during pregnancy could lead to birth defects and stunt mental abilities and growth. Also found in explosives, glue, paint thinner.

- × Miscarriages
- × Difficulty conceiving
- × Cancer





Other Health Concerns

- □ Acute symptoms & illnesses
 - Respiratory illness
 - **□** Rashes and skin irritation
 - Nose and throat irritation
- □ Chronic pain
 - □ Carpal tunnel
 - Back pain



Other Workplace Concerns

- Regular exposure of multiple chemicals at high levels
- Poor ventilation system
- Lack of culturally & linguistically appropriate materials and trainings
- □ Ergonomics
