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Recovery Bridge Housing (RBH) Survey

Recovery Incentives Program Benefit Update

- Anticipated start date: Quarter 1 of 2023 and will run through March 2024
- Recovery Incentives Program Providers must meet the following criteria:
 - √ Pass the Virtual Site Readiness Review
 - ✓ Have at least 3 staff per site who have completed all trainings
 - ✓ Have a valid DHCS Lab Registration with a Federal CLIA Waiver for each <u>site</u>
- Recovery Incentives Program Informational Notice



Recovery Incentives Program Training Update

Each site must have a CM Coordinator, Backup Coordinator, and a CM Supervisor complete the following trainings in order to participate in the Recovery Incentive Program pilot:

- CM Overview Training
- CM Implementation Training Part 1
- CM Implementation Training Part 2



Early Intervention Services – ASAM 0.5

- New benefit launched in October 2022
- ASAM 0.5 services for youth and young adults who do not meet medical necessity for SUD
- A full ASAM assessment and/or SUD diagnosis is not required to access Early Intervention services, however an ICD-10 diagnosis code is required
- All contracted treatment providers and CENS that serve youth/young adults, aged 12-20 must use the ASAM Screener for Youth and Young Adults
- A contract change notice for the addition of ASAM 0.5 will be sent out to each provider contracted for ASAM 1.0



Required Trainings & Utilization of Early Intervention Services:

- Required trainings to be completed by June 30, 2023:
 - ✓ ASAM Screener Youth for Young and Young Adults (included in the ASAM Screener trainings provided by CST)
 - ✓ Healthy YOUth: Early Intervention Curriculum developed by SAPC in collaboration with APU
- Submit Healthy Youth Early Intervention Curriculum Training Attestation form to: sapcmonitoring@ph.lacounty.gov
- Utilization of Early Intervention Services so far:
 - Limited uptake
 - Upcoming meeting for ASAM 0.5 Adult Providers
