Medi-Cal Peer Support Certification Program Scholarships

DHCS has made a total of 5,000 Medi-Cal Peer Support Certification scholarships, available to be distributed by the California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA).

To be considered for a scholarship, individuals must be recommended by SAPC.

Interested providers must notify SAPC by email at ASOC@ph.lacounty.gov, and include:

- Recommended peer candidate's full name;
- Candidates Date of Birth;
- Provider agency name (place of employment for recommended peer candidate);
- Candidate's current position;
- Candidate's email and/or phone number;
- Name of candidate's direct supervisor; and
- Type of certification (grandparenting or initial certification)
