

# TECHNICAL READINESS REVIEWS



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<b>What are Technical Readiness Reviews?</b>	Meetings that are primarily advisory in nature and offer opportunities to share challenges and success in navigating the START ODS.
<b>What happens at these meetings?</b>	Introductions and overview followed by more focused discussions on provider status, barriers, suggestions, and clarification on requirements.
<b>Which staff should participate?</b>	Primarily staff responsible for clinical oversight, finance, billing, and intake, but any who would benefit can participate.
<b>Who from SAPC will attend?</b>	Interdisciplinary group representing several SAPC divisions.
<b>When will these take place?</b>	late October to mid January.
<b>How much time will this take?</b>	Readiness Review meetings should be no longer than 2 hours.
<b>How Should I Prepare?</b>	SAPC will contact Providers about 3-6 weeks in advance. Providers will be asked to complete a brief Readiness Review survey as well as CIBHS' <i>"Projecting Service Capacity and Revenue"</i> (webinar and template).
<b>Will this replace the annual monitoring visit?</b>	No. The annual monitoring visits will begin in 2018.
