PURPOSE

- Reach historically difficult to serve populations
- Increase patient participation and retention in treatment services
- Enhance family engagement, particularly for youth

ELIGIBILITY

- Opportunity open to any treatment provider with a current and active FBS workplan
- Targeting participation from at least 5-7 provider agencies
- Eligible levels of care and treatment services



APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Attestation form confirming interest in pilot
- Written policies for in-home services including:
 - Field safety plan
 - Confidentiality protocols
- SAPC will review submissions and provide approval

DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

- Patient signature or provider-documented verbal consent
 - Youth patients must provide consent from parent/guardian.
- Clinical Documentation
 - Selection of FBS as service delivery method in Sage
 - Provide justification for in-home FBS service provision
 - Note service delivery location
 - Note confidentiality practices, in alignment with requirements
- Claims
 - Include the appropriate place of service code within claims (12)



TIMELINE & NEXT STEPS

ACTION ITEM	TIMELINE
SAPC outreach and engagement with eligible providers	October 12 – October 22, 2021
Release official in-home expansion pilot via SAPC Memo	November 1, 2021
Initiate pilot application process	November 2021
Pilot implementation	November 2021 - June 2022
Pilot evaluation	July –August 2022
