## BACKGROUND/PURPOSE



#### **PURPOSE**

**EXPAND AWARENESS, REDUCE STIGMA, AND INCREASE KNOWLEDGE** of SUD and recovery options, including harm reduction and treatment.

#### **AUDIENCE 1**

#### FRIENDS/FAMILY/COMMUNITY

Individuals close to someone struggling with or at risk of developing an SUD. Those who are unaware they have an SUD.

#### **AUDIENCE 2**

#### **INDIVIDUALS WITH SUD**


Those struggling with SUD and need support/treatment. Those who have not sought treatment for whatever reason (95%).

#### Overdose Prevention and Response Training and Technical Assistance

#### **GOAL:**

To support Provider networks' ability to offer overdose prevention and education services to individuals services at their facilities.

#### **Activities:**

- > Focused on overdose prevention, response, and harm reduction in treatment facilities
- > Trainings encompass a range of activities that support effective overdose prevention education and in the distribution of overdose prevention kits.
- > All treatment providers MUST participate in this training

- Distribution ONLY to patients
- DO NOT use fentanyl test strips to test patients
- OPRTTA team will contact you to discuss how to distribute
- Track distribution

#### **Contents:**

- Two (2) 4mg doses of Naloxone Nasal Spray
- Two (2) Fentanyl Test Strips
- Printed materials
  - Good Samaritan Card
  - Naloxone Prescription Card
  - Fentanyl precaution card & Instructions
  - Overdose First Aid Manual
