

All newly arrived Immigrants and Refugees are required to have a medical examination, including TB screening, before entering the United States. Panel physicians designated by the U.S. Department of State provide these examinations in the person's country of origin using standardized protocols.

Those with TB related findings that do not prohibit them from entering the United States but need medical follow up after arrival in the U.S. are given a TB class designation by the overseas panel physician.

If you are a recently arrived Immigrant, Refugee, Asylee or Parolee with an overseas TB classification and have not been contacted by the local public health staff, then please follow the link below to locate the nearest Los Angeles County Public Health Center that can provide TB follow up services.
